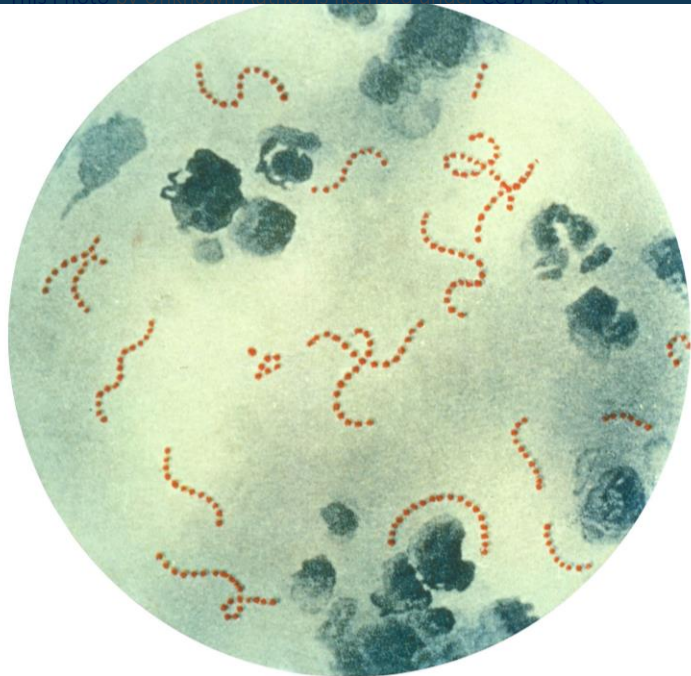

Can I Go to School Today?

Checklist for Determining Whether it is Safe to go to be on the FIA Campus

- Do I have any underlying medical conditions and vulnerabilities that might infect others?
- Have I had recent illness or symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 that might spread to others?
- Are there special circumstances or someone sick in the home environment that should be contained at home?
- Have I given special considerations to school transport where I or others might be contagious?

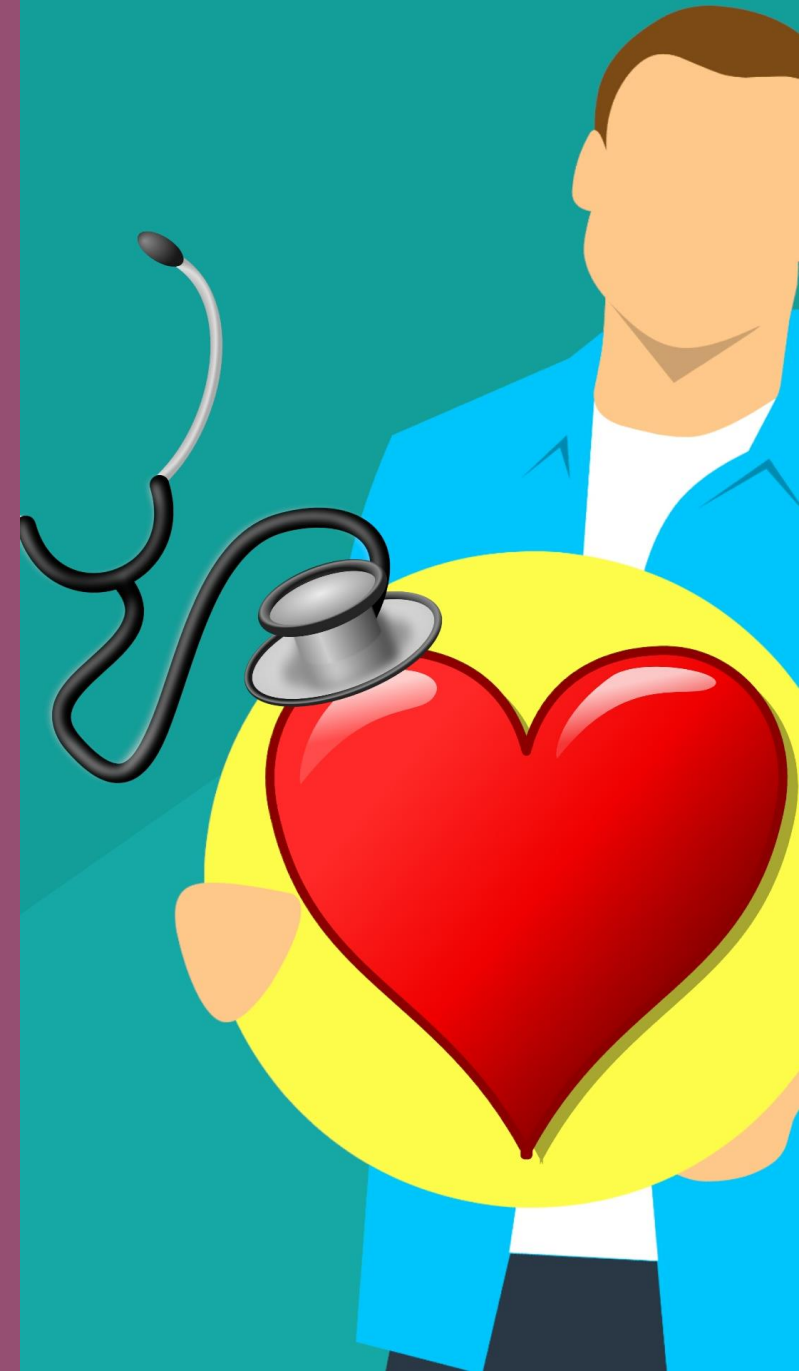
Stay at home if unwell!! Temperature above 37.5°C or 99.5°F is a concern and cause to stay home or be quarantined



Progressing on our Fall Semester!

We will all study, interact and play wisely

- Protect the health and safety of students, staff and families
- Follow the guidelines set out by the Jamaican Ministries of Health and Education
- Provide students and families with information about school routines for socio-emotional and academic learning
- Provide clear expectations for students and staff under familiar but very different conditions for learning and being together.
- These expectations apply to all persons on campus, not just students
- Maintain full access to activities, shared experiences and interactions on campus



How we will prevent or respond to fevers

THESE STEPS WILL BE OBSERVED

1. EVERYONE entering the school will be tested for fever at the entrance (**Must be below 37.5°C or 99.5°F**) at drop-off and perhaps during the day.
2. ANYONE found to have a fever will **not** be allowed into the school or, if discovered during the day, will be isolated and sent home immediately
3. CAMPUS WILL BE CLOSED if there is a government mandate or we find enough cases to warrant a deep cleaning and isolation of the campus (could be a couple of days, up to two weeks)

How we will clean, anticipate & adapt

THESE STEPS WILL BE ENFORCED

1. The entire school will be cleaned twice a day with bleach-based cleaning products.
2. Students and staff will clean their own areas before and after use, using wipes and sanitizing gel they carry with them at all times.
3. Anyone found with fever symptoms during the day will be isolated, attended to and removed from campus.
4. People related to anyone found feverish in school will be questioned, isolated and tested for symptoms.
5. Areas in contact with anyone found feverish during the day will be given an immediate deep cleaning, and closed off, if necessary.

Required Habits: Your Health & Others' Health

Your **COVID** habits should always be consistent:

- Keep your mask on unless you are told that you can remove it temporarily
- Carry your own supply of wipes and sanitizer gel
- Wash hands 20 seconds before/after entering the building. You will be tested for fever
- Leave basic materials at school only for YOU
- Maintain the 6-foot physical distancing, indoors and outdoors.
- Stay home if you are or might be infected. Also, stay home if someone at home is infected. When in doubt, be seen by a doctor.





Must-Do! It's Common Sense

Your new habits need to be practiced as HABITS!

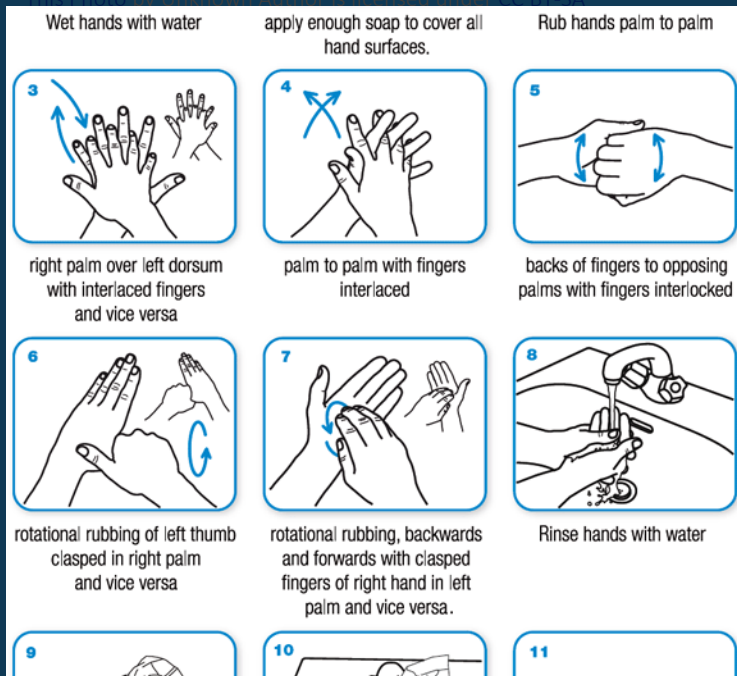
- Physical/social distancing (specifically, staying 3 feet away from others when you must go into a shared space)
- Frequent soap-washing hands or use of alcohol-based (at least 62 - 70% alcohol) hand sanitizers when hands are not visibly soiled and soap and water are not available
- Respiratory hygiene (proper, clean mask), wearing clean cloth face masks. MOHW mask etiquette must be observed
- Avoiding the touching of eyes, nose, and mouth
- Staying home when sick
